



Annual Report 2014

A meeting from the 300m European Cup Subcommittee was held in Winterthur, Switzerland, during the European Cup Final.

Ten nations were present during the General Assembly and the Chairman informed them about the news and all changes, including the new time schedule for 2015. The chairman was asking the nations about the approval, and all approved the changes.

All new changes and rules were submitted to the Technical Committee of the ESC to get the official approval.

Competitions:

Zagreb (CRO):

The competition took place from the 21.-24.05.2014. The competition was very well organized.

Lahti (FIN):

The competition took place from the 26.-29.06.2014. The competition in combination 25m/300m was very well organized.

Aarhus (DEN):

The competition took place from the 14.-18.08.2014. The competition was very well organized with the same organizing committee from last year.

FINAL:

This took place from the 9.-12.10.2014 in Winterthur (SUI). The ESC technical delegate Willi Grill will send his report to the ESC office at the end of the competition.

Very high scores were achieved on this shooting range this year. Eva Roesken GER obtained a new European record in the discipline 300m rifle three positions women with a score of 589 points. Cyril Graff FRA equalled the European record in the discipline 300m rifle three positions men with a score of 1179 points.

Meeting from the Sub Committee:

The definite form of the 300m European Cup Rules changes and the calendar 2015 were adopted.

General Meeting with the coaches present:
