RE: ESC COACH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Dear Colleagues,

At the General Assembly of the European Shooting Confederation in Ljubljana, Slovenia 2015 the idea of introducing a Development Program for coaches was presented. The ESC Member Federations approved this new project, thanks to the income from the ESC participation at the European Games in Baku 2015. The program is a co-operation with the ISSF Training Academy.

The ESC Presidium has decided to focus on the following parts of the project to start with;

- **D Courses** for Regional Coaches
  - Hosted by one Member Federation, possibly with participation from other countries – if the students can speak the same language.
  - The ESC will cover the cost of the instructor(s) from the pool of ISSF authorised instructors for a number of courses during 2016.
- **C Courses** for Coaches with experience as national coaches
  - These courses are conducted in the English language.
  - The ESC will support a small number of students participating at ISSF organized C-courses by paying the course fee (€ 1.250) directly to the ISSF.
- **B Courses** for Coaches that have successfully completed the C Course and accordingly are holding a C License.
  - The ESC will support one (1) or two (2) students participating at ISSF organized B-courses by paying the course fee (€ 1.250) directly to the ISSF.

The ESC is constantly supporting gender equality within the shooting sport and hence we are looking forward to receiving applications also from female coaches.
