To the National Federations – ESC members

February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017

Dear Colleagues,

Five months are left before the 26<sup>th</sup> General Assembly of the European Shooting Confederations takes place in Baku, Azerbaijan, on July 21<sup>st</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2017. Among the issues on the agenda there will be discussion of proposals from the Member Federations, decisions on hosts of the European Championships in 2020-2021, elections of the President, Vice-Presidents, Presidium members, Chairpersons of the Permanent Committees and the Auditors.

In this connection I would like to remind that, according to Article 5.3 of the ESC Statutes, in order to be included in the agenda to be considered at the General Assembly, the President (even per facsimile or e-mail) must receive the matters in one of the official languages at least three (3) months before the General Assembly convenes.

Also, according to Article 3.3 of the ESC General Regulations, at least three (3) months in advance of the General Assembly at which the organizing Federation will be chosen, a Member Federation desiring to organize a European Championship must submit an application to the ESC Secretariat. The applications will be accepted for the 2020 European Championship 10m, the 2020 European Championship Shotgun, the 2020 European Championship Juniors 25m/50m/RT, the 2021 European Championship 10m and the 2021 European Championship 25m/50m/300m/RT/Shotgun. Further details regarding the duties of the Organizers of European Championships may be found at the ESC Website under the Official Documents section: <http://esc-shooting.org/documents/official/>. Please don't hesitate to contact the ESC Secretariat for any inquiries.

It means, that all proposals on matters to be included in the agenda of the General Assembly and applications for the European Championships in 2020-2021 must be submitted by the Member Federations no later than April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017.
