RE: TV COVERAGE OF THE 2018 EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP 10M IN GYÖR

Dear Colleagues and Friends,

Less than a month is left till the opening of the first major ESC competition of the year – the 2018 European Championship 10m in Győr, Hungary. Now, when the final registration is over, we can expect the record number of Member Federations taking part in this Championship. Athletes from 48 countries are supposed to compete in Győr!

As we have informed you before all necessary arrangements for TV coverage of the Championship had been done by the Organizing Committee, the Hungarian Shooting Federation and the European Shooting Confederation. On January 13th, 2018 the European Broadcasting Union has placed the Eurovision Live Events Offer with program and timing of the transmissions.

The live TV broadcasting will include the Finals in six Olympic events: Air Rifle Men, Air Rifle Women and Air Pistol Mixed Team on February 23rd as well as Air Pistol Men, Air Pistol Women and Air Rifle Mixed Team on February 24th.

The access to the EBU signal will be possible only with written permission from the European Shooting Confederation (ESC). In order to get such permission TV companies which are interested to access the signal must apply to the ESC Secretariat

(esc@escsport.eu) and pay the applicable rate of 1000 (one thousand) Euro for the broadcasting rights on the territory of their country.

In order to allow the audience in all the countries to follow the competitions of the best European shooters, the costs of the technical access to the EBU satellite of all the TV companies will be covered by the ESC.

It means, each Member Federation has a real opportunity to promote the shooting sport, the athletes and the partners. There is still time to contact the local TV companies and sponsors in order to allow the audience in your countries to enjoy the competitions of the best European and National shooters.
