The 2019 Running Target European Championship in 50m events will take place in Gyenesdiás, Hungary from 8th to 15th July 2019. All member federations of the European Shooting Confederation are invited to participate without any exception.

The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the European Championship can be found above. The Final Competition Schedule including training schedule will be distributed after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the official arrival day). The latest updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

3. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The European Championship will be conducted according to ESC General Regulations and ISSF Rules and Regulations Edition 2018 (Second Print V1.1, 01/2018).

Information about rules of running target events is available on the ESC website www.esc-shooting.org

In case of disagreement in the interpretation of the rules, the valid English text shall prevail.

Jury members (Jury of Appeal, RTS Jury and Equipment Control Jury) will be nominated by ESC to supervise the European Championship.

The equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF rules using approved instruments.

4. PARTICIPATION AND ENTRY PROCESS

European Championship

ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual event as indicated in the ESC "General Regulations" (article 6.5.5).

In Mixed Team Competitions two (2) teams per country are allowed to be entered. Mixed nation teams are allowed.

Participants in the Mixed Team competitions must participate in the respective individual events.

Preliminary Entries

ESC Member Federations entering the 2019 Running Target European Championship in 50m events must submit their Preliminary Entries not later than **April 30, 2019**

For Preliminary Entries please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <http://entry.issf-sports.info> or exceptionally complete the attached Preliminary Entry Form (Annex 1.1, 1.2) and return it to the ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee by fax or email.

Final Entries

ESC Member Federations must forward their Final Entries for Athletes and Officials directly to ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee not later than the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the official arrival day) that is **8 June, 2019**.

For Final Entries please use the ISSF Online Registration Service at <http://entry.issf-sports.info> or exceptionally complete the Final Entry Forms (Annex 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 6) and return them by fax to ISSF Headquarters at +49 89 544 355 44.

Late Entries

Late Entries will be allowed to participate only according to the corresponding ESC and ISSF rules (ESC General Regulations 9.4.2; ISSF rule 3.7.3.4.).

Any additional entries received after the deadline of three (3) days before the official arrival day i.e. **July 5, 2019** will not be taken into consideration (ESC General Regulations 9.4.4, ISSF Rule 3.7.3.5).

Replacements

Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete for the Championship is permitted. This change can only be made before 12.00 a.m. on the day before the pre-event training for that event (ESC General Regulations 9.4.5, ISSF Rule 3.7.3.6).

Entry confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders are required to report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. This confirmation must take place before 1200 hrs on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Cancellations

Any Federation that reduces the number of athletes and/or officials after the final entry deadline is obliged to pay all applicable fees and costs including entry fees according to the number of entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate (ISSF Rule 3.7.4.3, ESC General Regulations 7.3).

ISSF ID number

According to ESC General Regulations, all athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number before participation in any ESC Championship. No athlete without an ISSF ID Number will be allowed to participate.

5. ENTRY FEES

Entry fees

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

All bank transfers must be made in EUR and must include any fees the bank may charge. Please take care that all necessary data are indicated, so that the Organizing Committee can assign payments to the federation concerned. Please give a copy of the bank transfer slip to your Team Leader to bring it as proof of payment to the Entry Confirmation at accreditation.

6. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation of all participants, officials, guests and members of the press will take place upon arrival at the venue. Accreditations will be prepared by the Accreditation Office of the European Championship. Accreditations and BIB numbers will be distributed after full payment of the entry fees and/or accommodation costs due. Such payments can be fulfilled in cash in EUR during the accreditation. Please note that no credit cards or traveller checks will be accepted on site!

7. LOCATION AND VENUE

Location

Located in the north-western part of one of the Hungary's most popular touristic destinations, Lake Balaton, Gyenesdiás is a colourful small city not far away from world-known resort Hévíz. The summer period makes Gyenesdiás specially dynamic and bustling city.

Shooting range

The Championship will take place at the picturesque Shooting Range of BEFAG Keszthely Shooting Club in Gyenesdiás.

The shooting range will be equipped with 2 pcs SIUS Ascor electronic targets. The European Championships will be conducted in full respect with ESC and ISSF Rules.

The necessary ranges, offices, storage facility, equipment control premises, dressing rooms, athletes lounge will be provided in compliance with ESC Rules.

Access

The venue can be reached easily by:

by car: M7 motorway alongside the southern coast of Lake Balaton through exit 170 following the direction to Keszthely (Route 71). Gyenesdiás is located right next to Keszthely.

by plane: Budapest International Airport "Ferenc Liszt" (BUD) is the official airport of the event located approximately 200 kms (120 mins by road) from Gyenesdiás. Arriving at the official airport, transportation will be arranged from the airport to the official hotel.

8. VISA

European Union citizens will be able to enter Hungary with a valid passport or identity card. Non-European Union citizens are advised to check the visa requirements well in advance.

Each participating federation requiring visa should fill out the "Visa Support Form" (Annex 5) and return it to the Organizing Committee within the deadline. Personalized invitation might be necessary for your delegation to apply for a visa.

9. IMPORT PROCEDURES

The temporary import of small-bore weapons to Hungary requires official import procedures. Whether teams arrive by plane or car, team leaders must have the invitation letter and the list of weapons duly stamped by their federation with them to perform customs procedures accordingly (Annex 4). The European Firearms Pass allows you to enter Hungarian territory with the weapon concerned.

10. ARRIVAL, ASSISTANCE, AIRPORT PICK-UP

Round trip transportation from/to Budapest „Liszt Ferenc” International Airport to the official hotel will be arranged by Well Travel, the official travel agency to the Championships. Booking of transportation can be added to your hotel reservation online at <http://welltravel.hu/booking/ech2019gyenesdias>

All delegations arriving by plane will be met at the airport and escorted to transportation. Everybody - who made reservation through the official travel agency Well Travel - will be picked up and transported to the hotel/airport, even if the team members arriving/departing with different flights.

11. LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

Daily shuttle bus service will be provided from/to the official hotel to/from the shooting range in Gyenesdiás throughout the whole duration of the Championship. Participants who are not accommodated through Well Travel at any of the official hotels will be responsible for their own transport.

There will be no shuttle service available before the official arrival day (July 8) and after the official departure day (July 15)!

14. DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping control will be conducted by the National Anti-doping Authority of Hungary in accordance with the current ISSF Anti-Doping Regulations and under the supervision of an ESC Anti-Doping Officer as well as the Technical Delegate.

15. MEDIA

All media representatives of the relevant ESC countries will be invited through the ESC member federations. Before attending the Championship, all media representatives must register by sending the "Media Accreditation Form" (Annex 3) to the Organizing Committee.

16. CEREMONIES

The **Opening Ceremony** will take place at the range on July 9 at 6:00 pm.
The **Closing Banquet** will be organized on July 14 at 7:00pm

The Banquet will have a cost of EUR 25,00 per participant; payments must be made to the Organizing Committee during accreditation.

17. NATIONAL ANTHEM AND FLAG

Each delegation is required to provide its own national anthem in a digital file format (preferably MP3). The digital anthem-file must be sent to the Organizing Committee, not later than June 8, 2019.

National flags will not be necessary to bring by the participating federations, they will be provided by the Organizing Committee.
