Dear ESC delegates.

Norway and the Norwegian Shooting Association hereby apply for arranging the European Championship 10 m air weapon in 2022 or 2023. It would be my greatest pleasure as president of the federation to welcome Europe's best air weapon shooters to a new championship in Norway. All ESC Member Federations will be invited and all the requirements of the ESC General Regulations and the ISSF Rules will be strictly observed.

Sport shooting is big and has long athletic traditions in Norway. The different Norwegian shooting organizations comprise approximately 500 000 members. Among other sports shooters have won most medals for Norway in the Summer Olympics and the sport is therefore as such top ranked in Norway.

Norway has arranged the European Championship air weapon 3 times before. First in Oslo in 1980, then in Stavanger in 1988 and then in Meråker in 2010. We are now ready for a new European Championship in Norway. This time in the center of the country, close to the main airport, in a city named Hamar with 90.000 residents and with the shooting ranges in the Viking Ship – the hall for the big moments. 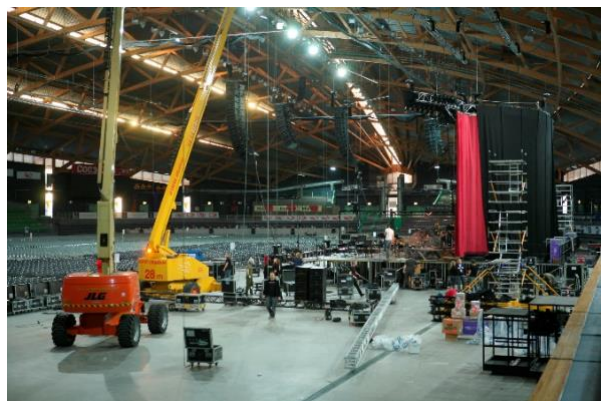
ECH in the Viking Ship, Hamar

March 18th – 27th 2022 (March 17th – 26th 2023)



The shooting range: The Viking Ship – For the Big Moments.

The Championship will be organized in the Viking Ship in Hamar, Norway. The Viking Ship is an indoor speed skating sports hall built for the 1994 Olympics at Lillehammer. In the off-season they organize all kind of activities, exhibitions, concerts and indoor sports. 26 000 square meters offers room for opportunities.

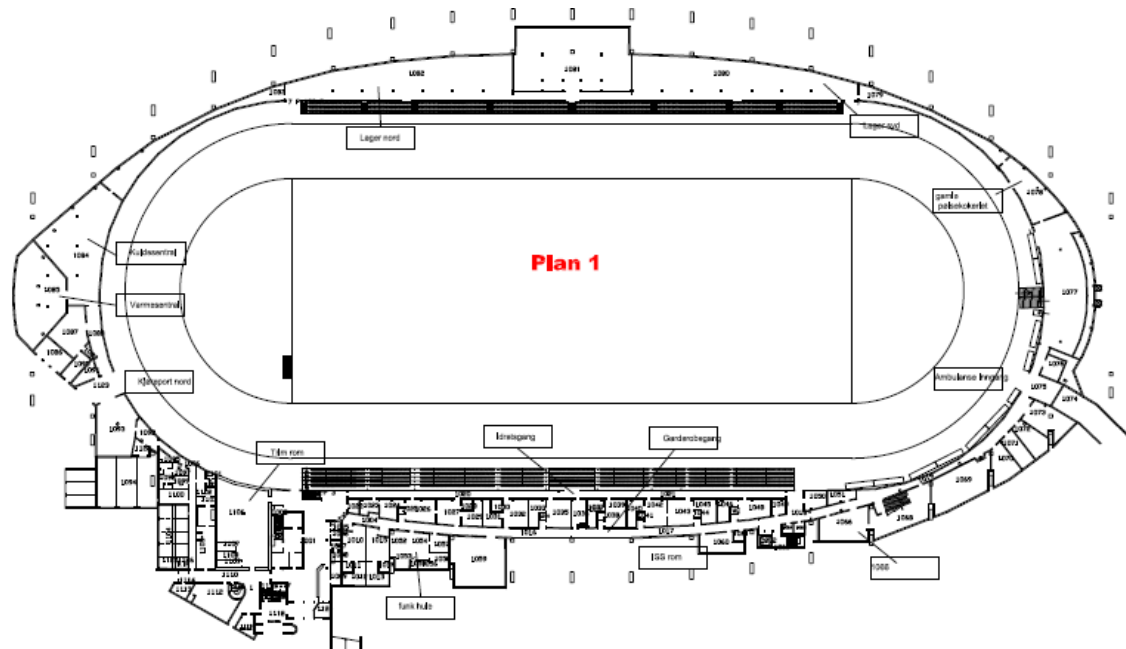


Today, the hall has a business that extends far beyond sports activities. Here, large fairs, exhibitions, anniversaries and cultural events are carried out annually. We have broad expertise in the planning and implementation of all types of events and our creative staff has first-class certificates from previous organizers.

The Viking Ship is a world-famous monumental building. "Room concepts" where you utilize the building's exciting shapes, the large area and the formidable space between floor and ceiling, provide opportunities to create an event with a new and exciting profile.

The venue will be built up as a shooting arena for air weapons to suit and facilitate the European Shooting Championship with:

- Classification 80 firing points
- Final Hall 1 10 firing points
- Final Hall 2 10 firing points
- Running Target 4 firing points

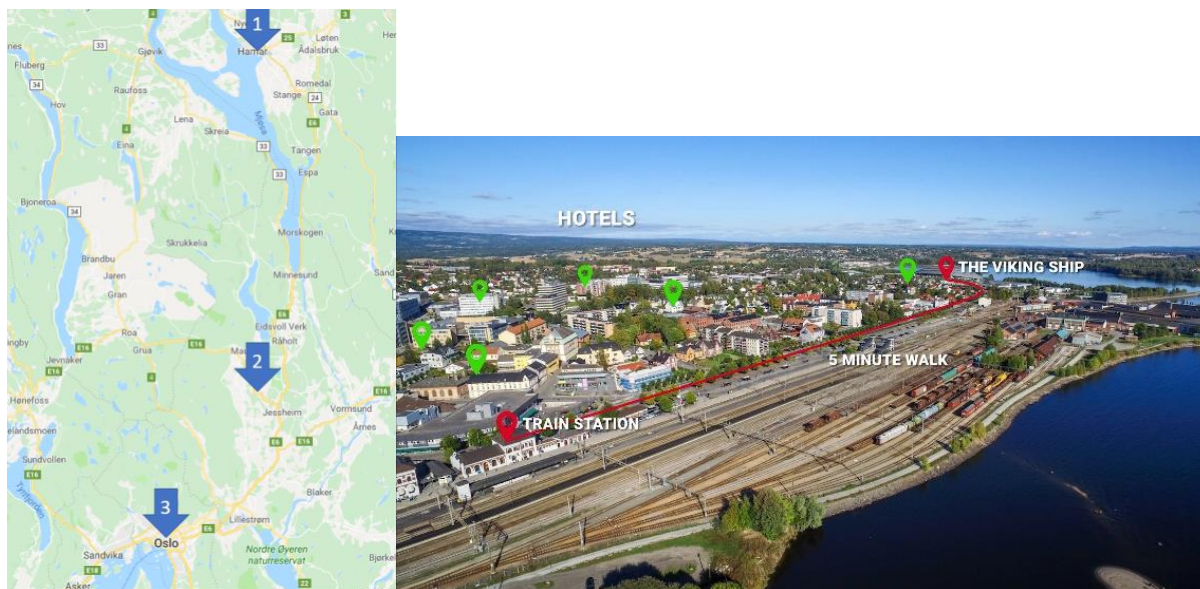

Accreditation (starting number, program, awards etc.)

Staff members will welcome athletes, officials and others for accreditation. All nations and competitors will have an accreditation bag with program, starting number, competitors award, ads, etc. A laminated accreditation card with picture will be made.

Press/media

A local press officer is responsible for informing local/national media and sponsors. There will also be a press officer directly responsible for international media and result announcements during the championship. There will also be established a press center with access to fax and our quick internet connection (optical fiber connection).

Catering

Breakfast is included at the hotels.

Lunch bags will be available in the Viking Ship, and there will be cafeteria in the venue.

Dinner and a variety of meals are available in the city and at the hotels.

Close to the athletes' hotel, Scandic, we plan to organize a banquet the last Saturday evening.

Spectators

During the EC the use of electronic targets and internet possibilities will be utilized to provide spectators and the public with the best result announcements, installing wide screens in the public areas and showing results live on the internet. We will establish a separate home page for the championship based on the rules ESC will have at the time.

There will be huge space for spectators at the final range and at the range for qualifying rounds.

Jury & RTS

The juries will have their own area with food and beverage at their disposal in the Viking Ship on the 1st floor.

Organizing committee

The organizing committee will be made official before the end of 2019 when we know whether we will host the Championship or not. The main committee consists of, besides the officials for the

Championship like juries, doping tests and other representatives:

- Main Director
- Chief of Staff
- Chief of Event
- Chief of Logistics
- Chief of Web, results & Live
- Chief of Transportation
- Chief of Finance
- Chief of Volunteers

Staff and organizers

We have estimated a use of 25 000 volunteer hours for the period of 2019–2022 (eventually 2023). During the championships we plan to use approximately 120 volunteers. We have very good expertise available within local clubs such as Hamar Sportsskytterklubb, Elverum Rifleklubb, Kisen Miniatyrskytterlag, Ørland Pistolklubb and Oslo Sportskyttene.

Caretakers are at our disposal before, during and after the championship.

Equipment Storage and Control

Manned equipment storage room is located close to the qualifying round shooting range. Equipment control according to ISSF rules and regulations.

Award ceremonies

Award ceremonies in the main venue immediately after the finals.

Restroom for competitors and officials

There are 10 changing rooms for the athletes, all 10 with separate toilets and shower and a separate room/area for officials with possibilities for food and beverages.
