Delegation:	8 shooters Men 6 shooters Women 2 Officials per event 5 shooters can be employed and only these 5 shooters for Men and Women count to get points in the EC.
Shooting Events:	300m Rifle Prone Men 300m Rifle 3 Positions Men 300m Standard Rifle Men 300m Rifle Prone Women 300M Rifle 3 Positions Women
Program:	See annex
Entry fees:	90.00 Euro per athlete and per event 90.00 Euro per nation and all events (3 shooters)
Transportation:	The transfer of the participating complete teams from the airport of Zurich or Basel and from the railroad station of Thun to the accommodation is free of charge. As well free of charge will be the transport from the hotel to the shooting range for those teams who arrive without own vehicles (shuttle service).
Meals:	Food and drinks may be purchased on site.
Banquet:	The banquet will be organized on 27 th August 2015.
Accommodation:	All nations must be its own responsibility to make booking accommodations. The payment must be made directly at the rented hotel. Possible contact see link below: thun@thunersee.ch or reservation@interlakentourism.ch
Equipment control:	The equipment control will be open daily during training and competition times.
Ceremonies:	The awards ceremonies will be every day after the competitions. The organising Committee doesn't need any flags or anthems from the delegations. There will be no opening or closing ceremony performed.
Arms storage:	Please note that's not anymore allowed to leave weapons and ammunition at the shooting range during the night. A storage for
