Athletes being **European Union Citizens** in order to import their firearm into Greece, have to own and carry the **European firearm passport** for the shotgun that they want to import.

Athletes being **non-European Union Citizens**, have to send to the Organizing Committee all the necessary details of their trip to Greece (exact dates of flights, passport details and the exact characteristics of their shotgun) **no later than the 10/9/2022.**

It is the responsibility of the shooters before the arrival to fill in the **form** before your arrival in Greece with all information needed about the firearm and the ammunitions to bring in Greece.

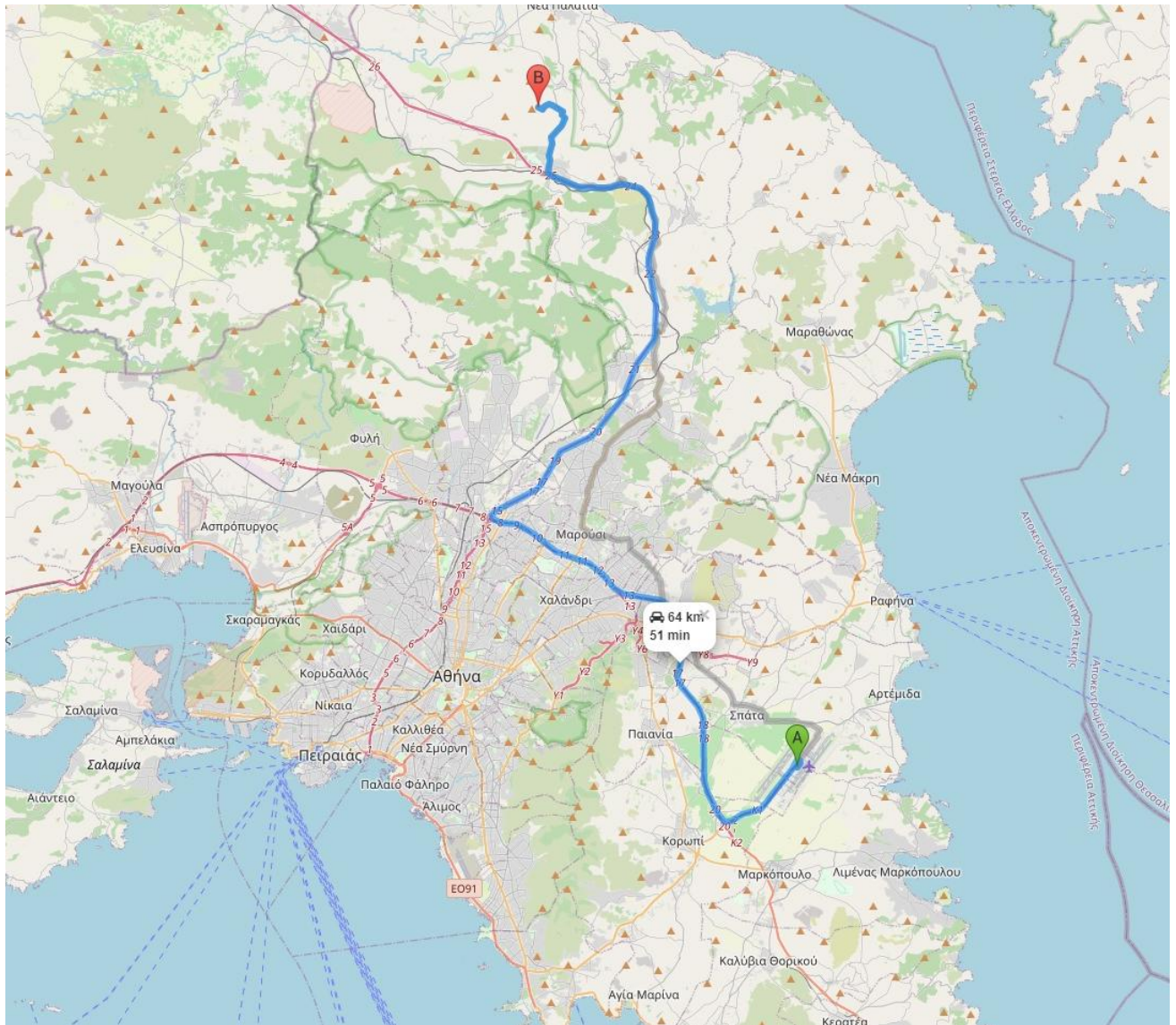

“How to Get There”

Participants will be responsible for their own means of local transportation.

Malakasa Shooting Complex (MSC) is located Near Athens the Capital of Greece is accessible. Depending whether you enter Greece by Air, Ferry Boat or Car, following are main ways to get to MSC:

1. By Air through (a) Eleftherios Venizelos Airport (ATH) of Athens city or (b) Makedonia Airport (SKG) of Thessaloniki city.
2. By Ferry Boat from Ancona – Italy, through (a) Igoumenitsa Port or Patra Port.
3. By Ferry Boat through Piraeus Port.
4. By Car through the border with (a) Albania, (b) Bulgaria or (c) Turkey.



All major Rent-A-Car companies are represented at both ATH and SKG Airports. While the roads have sufficient signage in English Language, it is recommended the use of a GPS.

Additionally, there is sufficient 5G “COSMOTE” mobile network coverage throughout.
