Dear Colleagues,

It is my pleasure to herewith officially invite you to the XXIX Ordinary General Assembly of the European Shooting Confederation that will take place in Baku, Republic of Azerbaijan, on October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023, in the Khazri Recreation and Healthy Centre.

Enclosed you will find the Agenda, the Periodic report of the Presidium and other documents related to the Agenda according to art. 5.4 ESC Statutes.

The GA Delegates form can be found on the ESC website (<http://esc-shooting.org/documents/ESCGA/>). Please, return the completed forms to the ESC Secretariat by e-mail [esc@escsport.eu](mailto:esc@escsport.eu).

On the ESC website using the link mentioned above you can also find the Registration form. This form must be filled in and sent to the Organizing Committee ([info@aze-shooting.org](mailto:info@aze-shooting.org)) as well as to the ESC Secretariat.

Let me remind that the ESC Statutes determine the norms of representation of Member Federations at the General Assembly:

- According to Art. 5.8, one Member Federation representing all shooting sports in a country will have two votes and may be represented by one or two delegates;
- According to Art. 5.9, if a country is represented by two Member Federations, each of them is entitled to one vote and one delegate;
- According to Art. 5.10, a Member Federation that represents one (1) country together with another Member Federation may represent the other Member Federation from the same country by proxy which must be given in writing. Apart from that representation of Member Federations by proxy is not allowed.
- According to Art. 5.11, only the President, the Vice-Presidents, the Secretary General, the Executive Director and Executive Committee/Board members can represent their Member at the General Assembly. Participation forms for delegates must reach the Secretary General at least seven (7) working days prior to the opening of the General Assembly. All delegates representing the Members must provide documented proof of their appointment as a delegate of that Member.

In order to support participation in the meetings, the ESC will provide each Member Federation with a free standard room for 2 nights (October 20<sup>th</sup> -22<sup>nd</sup>).

The Member Federations applying for the European Championships 2026-2027 are welcomed to make presentations at the General Assembly. However, such presentations should have a maximum length of 5 minutes and should be handed over to the ESC Secretariat on October 20<sup>th</sup> at 14:00 latest.

I look forward to welcoming you all in Baku.
