

**ESC CHALLENGE  
INDIVIDUAL  
TRAP - SKEET  
U18**

**Description of the Format and Competition Rules**

**1. GENERAL**

- a) Unless otherwise specified in these rules the ESC Challenge Individual event is conducted and administered according to the ISSF Shotgun Rules for Trap and Skeet and any other relevant applicable rule contained in section 9 of the ISSF rulebook.

**2. PROGRAM - NUMBER OF TARGETS**

- a) The competition is composed of 75 targets (3 rounds X 25 targets each) shot in one (1) day only, without Final.
- b) Whenever possible the 3 rounds should be conducted on three (3) different ranges (1 round on each range).

**3. FINAL RANKING - CLASSIFICATION**

- a) The results will be classified on the basis of the total result of the 75 targets of each athlete ranked in descending order as per ISSF Rules.
- b) Any ties for the first three (3) places (Gold, Silver & Bronze Medals) will be decided by a shoot-off as per ISSF rules.
- c) Individual tied scores ranking 4th place and below, not decided by a shootoff, must be ranked according to the Countback rule. In case of an absolute tie, the tied athletes will share the same ranking, with their names listed in alphabetical order according to their family names as per ISSF Rules.
