 - At app will be pick up times

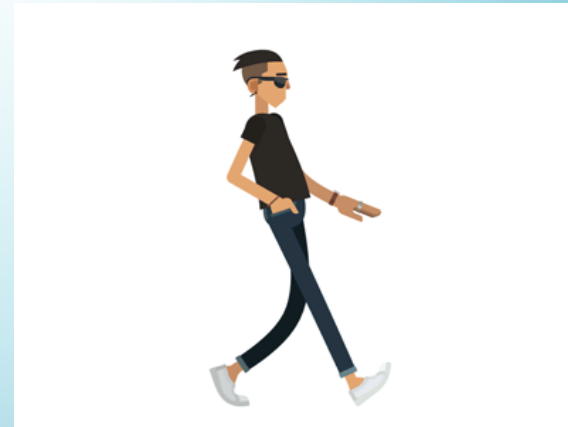

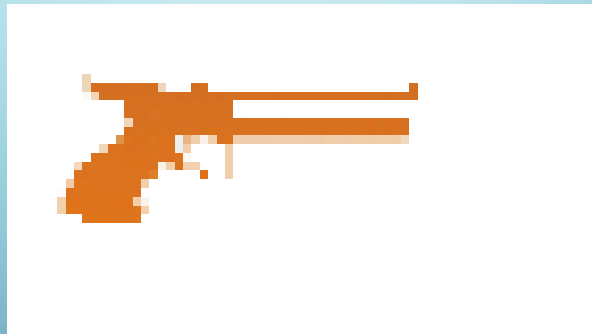
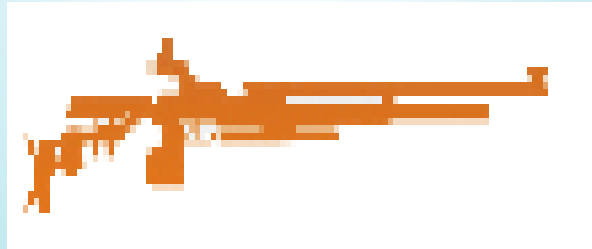

TECHNICAL INFORMATION: QUALIFICATIONS

ATTENTION: Changing to MATCH firing is done by SIUS

– Rifle Equipment must be in the back against the FOP.

You can bring Rifle with safety flag inserted

Dry firing at a designated part of range (by FP 1)

Don't forget to use the SAFETY FLAGS (rifle & pistol)

Coaches back of athlete (no running)

Pistol Athletes must wear their National shirt during the competition.

All team members must compete in the same uniform!!!

All Finals according to ESC RULES

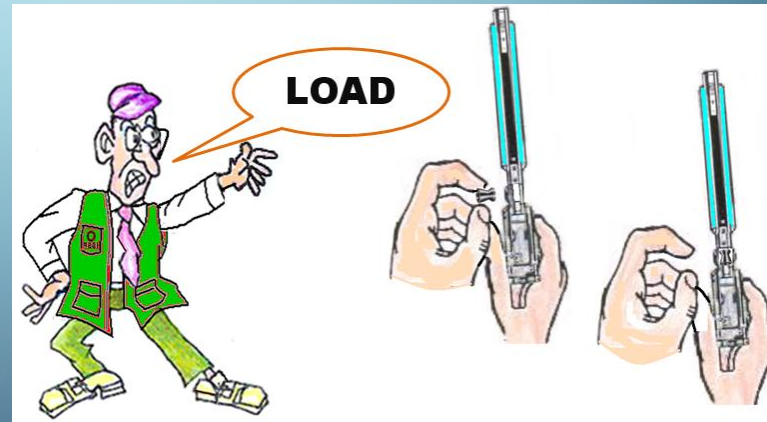
- All Athletes are presented during walk in
- Sighting
- Finals
- Time Out

Music will be played at any time in finals and in Qualification as well



Definition Load:

A gun is considered loaded when a cartridge or pellet or a magazine with cartridges contacts a gun. No one may place a cartridge or pellet or magazine with cartridges in or on a gun or its chamber or barrel until the command **“LOAD”** is given.





During Award Ceremonies, medalists MUST present themselves in their official national uniforms or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms). Athletes without a national uniform will not be allowed to enter the podium (Jury Members will check).

The Award Ceremonies will take place immediately after the end of each final, in approx. 10 minutes time. Athletes must bring their uniform to the Call Room when reporting for the Final.

Have also in mind the picture of the medalists, which is to be taken on the FOP immediately after every final. Therefore, no coaches to approach their athlete until after the picture has been taken.
