1. AGE CATEGORY

Athletes can compete in the U-18 age category, as per ESC General Regulations (art. 11.5) (Athletes can compete in U-18 European Championships until the 31st December of the year in which they become 18 years of age. Any athlete born between the 1st January and the 31st December loses the right to compete in U-18 category on the 31st December of that year).

4. SHOOTING RANGE

The ESC Championships will take place at the Malakasa Shooting Range which is located around 50km away from Athens, the Capital of Greece.

The shooting range has 5 combined ranges for Trap/Skeet and is equipped with 2021 & 2025 Promatic Trap machines with Elettronica Progetti acoustic release system.

All ranges are equipped with Led electronic scoreboards.

The firing direction of the shooting range is 41° North-East.

The targets used for the Championships are eco-friendly from Laporte, Standard orange for the Qualification and flash orange for the Finals.

5. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The ESC Championship U18 will be conducted according to the ESC General Regulations and ESC Challenge rules. Rules and Competition formats can be found on the ESC website: <https://esc-shooting.org/documents/escrules>

The Juries (Competition Jury, RTS/ Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ESC to supervise the Championship. Qualified Referees/Range Officers holding applicable ISSF Licenses will conduct the competitions.

Shotgun Equipment

All skeet athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have ISSF seals on the marker tapes must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to the Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

Cartridge Controls

During the competitions, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested, first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g or less, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50g, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weighs more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

As per ESC rules, by decision of the Jury cartridge controls may also be conducted during the Final stages of each event.

Colored Wads

Only transparent or translucent wads with no color may be used.

If an athlete uses ammunition that is not in accordance with ISSF Rule, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

6. PARTICIPATION

Individual Events

ESC Member Federations can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes in the individual events.

Team Events

No separate competitions. Ranking will be established according to the combined results of the three (3) athletes entered in the respective Individual events.

Solo

Each nation in each Solo event can participate with a maximum of three (3) athletes. The athletes participating in a Solo event are determined according to the Final Ranking of the respective Individual event, as per rules. The format of the Solo competition consists of duel/elimination Matches. The number of elimination stages will depend upon the number of participating athletes.

Duet

ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of three (3) pairs. Each of the two (2) athletes (1 boy and 1 girl) must be registered by the set deadline but may be changed for other athletes registered in the Championship by latest 12:00 the day before the start of the Competition. No mixed nation pairs are allowed.

Trio

ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of one (1) Trio. Each of the three (3) athletes entered in the competition must be registered by the set deadline but may be changed for other athletes registered in the Championship by latest 12:00 the day before the start of the Competition.

Maximum Entry

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each European Championship event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of shotgun ranges.

If the maximum number of starts (as decided by the OC) is reached during the Final Entry process, a “waiting list” for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. The ESC and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

ID Number

All athletes must have an ID number. It can be either the ISSF ID number or the ESC ID number obtained through the registration process.

The ESC ID numbers for all athletes under 18 years of age are free of charge.

7. PRELIMINARY ENTRIES

ESC Member Federations must submit their Preliminary Entries not later than March 21, 2025 using the ESC online Registration System esc-entry.eu

8. FINAL ENTRIES

The Final Entries must be made via the ESC online registration system esc-entry.eu before midnight (CET time) on the 30th day before the official arrival day (**May 27, 2025**).

All other forms (Final Travel Form, Final Hotel Reservation Form, Final Hotel Rooming List, Visa Support Form, Firearms and Ammunition Form, Media Accreditation Form) must be sent to the Organizing Committee to the following e-mails and no later than the indicated deadlines.

9. LATE ENTRIES

Any late entry accepted after the 30-day final entry deadline will incur an additional late entry fee for each athlete, each Duet or Trio entered in each event. (ESC General Regulation 13.3.4).

Any additional entries received after the deadline of three (3) days before the official arrival day i.e. June 24, 2025 will not be taken into consideration (ESC General Regulations 13.3.5).

10. REPLACEMENT

Replacement of a registered athlete for the Team events (Duet and Trio) by another already registered athlete for the Championship is permitted. This change can only be made before 12:00 pm (noon) on the day before the competition for that event (ESC General Regulations 12.10.).

11. ENTRY CONFIRMATION UPON ARRIVAL

All Team Leaders are required to report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. This confirmation must take place before 12:00 on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

12. CANCELLATION

Any reduction in the number of registered athletes and/or officials after the final entry deadline (**May 27, 2025**) requires payment of all applicable fees and costs, including entry fees, based on the original Final Entry Forms. In accordance with ESC General Regulations 14.7, unpaid fees will result in the federation's inability to participate.

Entry Fee

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels. All entry Fee Payments must be made to the Organizing Committee.

For the Member Federations participation of athletes in those ESC Challenge events is free of charge.

Registration, confirmation of entries, payments for entries, must be made to the Organizing Committee at the Registration Office at the Malakasa Shooting Range, upon arrival, **starting on 27.06.2025.**

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the Championship (Athletes, Team Officials, ESC/ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and with photograph in the official database) will be prepared by the Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the ECH Accreditation Office.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

13. IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS REQUIREMENTS

A. Visa procedures

New EU rules on short-stay visas apply worldwide from 2 February 2020. They make it easier for legitimate travelers to apply for a visa to come to Greece, facilitating tourism, trade and business, while providing more resources for countering irregular migration risks and threats to internal security.

All European Union citizens have the right to enter Greece by virtue of having an identity card or valid passport.

Nationals of the countries, of which the possession of a visa is required when crossing the external borders of the Member States :

For the participants of those countries, the Organizing Committee of the Hellenic Shooting Federation will write a letter, after their participation has been confirmed and after receiving the **VISA Support form (no later than 27/4/2025)**, to facilitate them to apply to the Greek Embassy in their own home country or nearest available Embassy or Consulate for an entry visa.

The Hellenic Shooting Federation has no influence on the embassy and can provide the invitation regarding the European Championships only!

B. GUN PERMITS

Owners of a European firearms passport may import their guns without an auxiliary permission to Greece.

All nations who do not belong to the European Union have to use the following procedure.

In order to be in compliance with Greek firearms laws, a firearms permit must be issued for the duration of the European Championships U-18 in Shotgun by the Greek State, for every single gun that will enter the country for the purpose of training and competition. For your assistance, it is required that a copy of the attached guns declaration form and a copy of the current shooting license in the competitor's home country be submitted for each athlete prior to the arrival of the athletes.

Import and Registration of Firearms and Ammunition

It is the responsibility of the National Federations before the arrival of their athletes to fill in the specific forms with all the necessary information concerning the sport guns and ammunition to be brought into Greece by their competitors. Upon their arrival at the Hellenic Custom Authorities, by filling in the specific attached forms, the sport equipment brought into Greece will be registered and it must be the same with the one declared by the National Federation.

Every person who has access to the sport guns must be registered.

The registration is valid for the duration of the competitor's stay in Greece and expires on the day of his/her departure.

As all competitors are under 18 years old, the Permits are issued in the name of the official/officials (chief of delegation, coach and/or parent) who import/s the sport guns. Note that absent the permit the guns will be detained by Greek Customs upon arrival and will not be released to the competitor/s until all necessary paperwork has been completed and permits issued.

All competitors and team officials must comply with the provisions of Greek guns laws and Customs Regulations for importation and re-exportation of guns.
The guns permit, as issued by the Hellenic State, requires that all guns will be re-exported at the end of competition and under no circumstances will remain in the country.

Please forward the enclosed information to your shooting athletes as well as any team official or team member who may handle athletes' guns in Greece.

It is recommended that all delegations carry a list of all firearms and ammunition with themselves (Guns and Ammunition excel file annex 5.2), to be presented to customs or border police upon request together with the invitation.

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on **28 June, 2025** at 14:00 at the shooting range.

Each participating ESC Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding the Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the Championships.

The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

Gun storage will be provided conveniently at the shooting range. Firearms and ammunition will not be transported to and from the hotels, except on departure. A storage space will be provided for equipment bags and ammunition at the shooting range. The armory will be checked every evening to be sure all guns are returned.

Upon arrival all delegations must take the transportation to the shooting range, leave the guns and go to the official hotels.

17. CEREMONIES

Opening & Closing Ceremonies

The Opening Ceremony will take place at the Malakasa Shooting Range on 28 June 2025 after the Technical Meeting, around 15:00 (exact time tba on 27/6/2025).

There will be no Closing Ceremony.

Victory Ceremonies

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range as per Final Competition Schedule.

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

18. WEATHER INFORMATION

Between 27 June and 3 July 2024, Malakasa, Athens, Greece, experiences typical summer weather with temperatures averaging 27-29°C (80-84°F). Minimum temperatures ranged from 21°C to 24°C (69.8-75.2°F), while maximum temperatures reached 31°C to 35°C (87.8-95°F) due to a heatwave impacting the region. The climate featured clear skies, dry conditions, and no significant rainfall.

Winds are mild, averaging 9-12 km/h (5.6-7.5 mph), predominantly from the north and northeast.
