



# GENERAL PROVISIONS 2025

## **1. DISCIPLINES**

The ECHL Shotgun will take place in Madrid, Spain from September 11-14.

The ECHL Air Rifle/Air Pistol will take place in Istanbul, Türkiye from October 1-5.

## **2. RULES AND REGULATIONS**

## **3. INTERNATIONAL TECHNICAL OFFICIALS**

The competitions will be conducted under the supervision of Technical Delegates, Juries, Referees, Judges and other officials with applicable international licenses who will be designated by the ESC.

## **4. QUALIFICATION / PARTICIPATION**

The three (3) highest-ranked national teams in each event in the Men's category and the three (3) highest-ranked national teams in the Women's category, according to the European Champions League Ranking at the end of the qualifying period, will be invited. The host nation will also receive one quota for one (1) team in the Men's and one (1) team in the Women's categories, making a total of four (4) teams per event, per category.

If the national team of the hosting Member Federation (Men or Women or both) is/are among the top three (3) ranked teams, then the 4<sup>th</sup> ranked team(s) in the European Champions League Ranking will be invited. If one or more qualified teams decline to participate in the Champions League for any reason, the next highest-ranked team(s) in the European Champions League Ranking will be invited.

## **5. RANKING**

The position of the teams in the European Champions League Ranking for each event will be determined by the addition of the ranking points of the two (2) top-positioned athletes from each country, in each category.

Points are awarded based on final placements of athletes in each event according to the following table:

Ranking points can be obtained at the following competitions:

- **Trap and Skeet:**  
ISSF WC in Nicosia, ISSF WC in Lonato del Garda, European Championship in Châteauroux - two events (individual and ESC Challenge Solo),
- **Air Rifle and Air Pistol:**  
European Championship in Osijek – two events (individual and ESC Challenge Solo),  
ISSF WC in Munich.

## **6. ELIGIBILITY AND SUBSTITUTIONS**

In case one of the two top-ranked athletes of the team cannot take part in the ECHL, he or she can be substituted by another athlete who has ECHL ranking points.

It is not possible to substitute both athletes who determined the position of the Team among the 3 top-ranked.

## **7. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS**

### **Grants to the Member Federations**

Each participating Member Federation, in each discipline, in each event will receive a grant in the amount of 5.000 Euro to prepare and send its Team(s) to the Tournament.

### **Prize money in each event**

1<sup>st</sup>place – 5.000 Euro

2<sup>nd</sup>place – 3.600 Euro

3<sup>rd</sup>place – 2.400 Euro

4<sup>th</sup>place – 1.200 Euro

## **8. ENTRY PROCESS**

The Qualified Teams will be notified by the ESC secretariat and will be asked to complete the online registration at the ESC Entry System <https://esc-entry.eu/home> by the established deadline.

## **9. ADDITIONAL INDIVIDUAL EVENT**

One individual ESC Challenge event – Solo – will be included in the program for athletes competing in the ESC Champions League. Prize money for each participating athlete will be established. The winner of each Solo competition will receive a special Trophy.

## **10. OFFICIAL HOTEL/ACCOMMODATION**

Each Team in each event, in each category, will be allocated in the official hotel, two (2) rooms (full-board) free of charge for accommodating its athletes and official(s) for a maximum of three (3) nights for Trap & Skeet and four (4) nights for Rifle & Pistol.

Additional accommodation or extra charges (telecommunication, mini bar, extra meals, laundry, etc.) that may occur must be paid directly to the hotel.
