

Invitation to the International Air Gun Competition Swedish Cup 2027

The Swedish Shooting Sport Federation and the Organizing Committee are happy to invite all shooters and leaders to take part in Swedish Cup 2027.

Competition dates are from January 2nd to January 5th, 2027.

The venue:

The competition will be arranged in our impressive venue Sävsjö Shooting Center. Sävsjö is located in the southern part of Sweden. In the arena we have over one hundred targets from Megalink for both air rifle and air pistol.

Program:

January 2: Arrival. Training (PET) 1300-1600.
January 2: Mixed Teams 17.00-20.00
January 3: First day of competition.
January 4: Second day of competition.
January 5: Third day of competition.

Shooting events:

Mixed Team (January 2nd only): One man/junior man and one woman/junior woman per team. The competition is limited to a maximum of 20 teams for rifle respective pistol and a maximum of 3 teams per nation.

Air Rifle/Air Pistol: Men/junior men, women/junior women.

Moving Target: Men/junior men, women/junior women.

Para shooters in class SH 1R: (R1) Men/junior men. (R2) Women/junior women.

Para shooters in class SH 1: (R3) Open class prone rifle.

Para shooters in class SH 2: (R5) Open class prone rifle.

Para shooters in class SH VIP: Open class prone rifle. (Shooter is responsible for bringing correct equipment).

Veterans Air rifle: Born in 1982 or earlier. Open class.

Veterans Air pistol: Born in 1982 or earlier. Open class.

Please note: Double start is not possible (for example, Open class and Veterans or Pistol and Rifle).

Entry process:

You find the entry form on the Swedish Cup official website. www.swedishcup.se.

Note: Entries to Mixed Team competition is made by team coach via email to swedishcup@skyttensport.net

Registration will be open until 15th of November 2026. In the event of a large number of entries the registration can be closed earlier.

To minimize our workload, we ask shooters not to register individual entry forms, but instead to use one entry form per club, if you are two or more shooters per club.

**Lunch:**

For those of you who want to pre-order lunch during the competition days, the menu looks like this:

2 January: Easier serving

3 January: Fish of the day / lasagna

4 January: Fish of the day / chicken and potato gratin

5 January: Fish of the day / pan steak & potatoes

Price 130 SEK, including drink, salad, crispbread

Entry fees:

Mixed Teams: 1000 SEK per team.

All individual classes: 1000 SEK per competitor for all three competition days.

Payment is to be made in connection with entry process.

Elevated entry fees for entries made after 15th of November 2026: 1500 SEK

Awards:

Medals to the top three shooters respective day in each class. And prizes for the overall best shooter in each class after the three competition days. Medals for the top three mixed teams.
