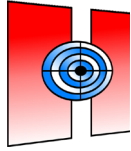

Delegation 6 Men and 6 Women athletes
Per competition (exception 8 Men or 8 Women athletes when participating Standard Rifle). These athletes must have an official ISSFD-number. Per event 5 athletes and 1 team can be employed 2 Officials

Shooting Events 300m Rifle Prone Men
300m Rifle 3 Positions Men
300m Standard Rifle Open
300m Rifle Prone Women
300m Rifle 3 Positions Women

Entry Fee 90.00 EUR per shooter per event.
Per competition The nation fees on 3 and more shooters are 90 € and you reduce proportionally (I.E.: one athlete 30 € – 2 athletes 60)

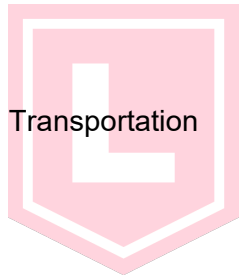

The Competition account: LOC will calculate the total entry and competition fees and send an invoice with bank details.

The bank vouchers must be presented at the time of accreditation

No payments can be made on the shooting range



Transportation

Transport between airport – official hotels – shooting range will be organized (15 € person)

Imports of firearms

When entering Croatia, you will need to have an invitation letter.

Persons with an EU firearm permits just have to show EU firearms permit to police officer and do not need to show any other forms or pay any taxes.

Persons arriving from outside the EU or don't have an EU firearm permits, will get an official form from the police when crossing the border, on which they can register up-to three weapons

Police will issue papers for these firearms, which you must show at departure during check-in and to the police officer.

The tax of 10 EUR is requested for every submitted form

Upon arrival to Croatia all firearms and ammunition must be transported directly to the Shooting range firearms storage.

At departure the firearms and ammunition must be collected from the firearms storage on the way to airport (not before).
