**3. RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Detailed information about the current ISSF Rules and Regulations is available on the ISSF website [www.issf-sports.org](http://www.issf-sports.org)

The **ESC Challenge events** will be conducted in accordance with the **ESC General Regulations** and the **ESC Challenge** rules. The rules and competition formats can be found on the ESC: <https://esc-shooting.org/documents/escrules>

The Juries (Competition Jury, RTS/ Equipment Control Jury) have been designated by the ESC to supervise the Championship. Qualified Referees holding the applicable ISSF Licenses will conduct the competitions.

**Shotgun Equipment**

All skeet athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have ISSF seals on the marker tapes must be submitted to Equipment Control Jury for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted in accordance with ISSF Rules using approved and calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for ensuring that their equipment and clothing comply with the applicable rules. All athletes are encouraged to submit any equipment or clothing they consider to be in doubt to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for verification prior to the competition.

All athletes are subject to random checks during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be **disqualified**.



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### **Cartridge Controls**

During the competitions, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested will be selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. **Two (2) plus four (4)** cartridges will be taken from each athlete and placed in separate labelled envelopes.

The **two (2)** cartridges must be tested first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50g or less, no further action will be taken. If one or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50g, the **four (4)** cartridges in the second envelope must then be tested. If the average weight of all **six (6)** cartridges exceeds 24.50g, the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

In accordance with ESC rules, the Jury may also decide to conduct cartridge controls during the Final stages of each event.

### **Coloured Wads**

Only transparent or translucent wads with no colour may be used.

**Any athlete found using ammunition that does not comply with ISSF Rules will be disqualified (DSQ).**

## **4. PARTICIPATION**

### **ISSF EVENTS**

#### **Individual Events (Men & Women)**

ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of **five (5)** athletes in each of the individual events.

A maximum of **three (3) athletes** per nation entered in the Trap and Skeet individual events may compete for **medals**. Up to **two (2) additional athletes** entered in the individual events may compete for **Ranking Points Only (RPO)**. RPO athletes cannot progress to the Final and cannot set records (ESC General Regulations, Rule 12.3).

For non-Olympic events, if more than three (3) athletes are entered, the additional athletes must be entered as RPO during the Online Registration process. However, at the European Championships, all athletes (including RPO athletes) compete under the same conditions.

#### **Team Events**

Only three (3) athletes from the same age category and gender may be registered as a team and must be officially declared at the Accreditation Office in accordance with ISSF Rules. **Only one (1) team per Member Federation** is permitted. All team members must compete in the competition. RPO athletes are not eligible to be part of a team.

#### **Mixed Team events**

ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of **two (2) teams**.



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### Individual Events (Juniors)

Athletes remain Juniors until 31\*\* December of the year in which they reach the age of 21 (ESC General Regulations, Rule 11.2).

At the European Championships for Juniors, each Member Federation may enter a maximum of:

- six (6) athletes in Individual events
- two (2) Mixed Teams
- three (3) Duet Pairs
- one (1) Team
- one (1) Trio

At least **two (2)** of the athletes entered in the **Individual** events must fall within the **U18 age** category.

A maximum of **three (3) athletes** per nation, being the three highest-ranked after Qualification, may proceed to the **Final** in accordance with ISSF Rules (Rule 3.7.5.3).

### ESC CHALLENGE EVENTS

#### Solo

The athletes participating in the Solo events are determined by the Final Ranking of the respective Individual events, in accordance with the rules (top 32 athletes in each of the Men's and Women's categories, and top 16 athletes in each of the Men's Junior and Women's Junior categories).

A maximum of three (3) athletes per nation may qualify for each Solo event.

The Solo competition is conducted in a duel/elimination format. The number of elimination stages will depend on the total number of participating athletes.

**\*\*\* Member Federations intending to participate in the Solo events must confirm their participation during the accreditation process \*\*\***

#### Duet

ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of three (3) pairs per Duet event, each consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman. However, only a maximum of **two (2) pairs** per Member Federation may proceed to the **Final** (Medal Matches). The third pair (Duet Pair 3) is not eligible to qualify for the Final (ESC General Regulations, Rule 12.4).

**Mixed-nation** pairs are NOT permitted.

#### Trio

ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of **one (1) Trio** team. Each of the three (3) athletes entered in the competition must be registered by the set deadline; however, they may



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be replaced by other athletes registered for the Championship no later than 12:00 (noon) on the day before the competition starts.

**Juniors may compete** as part of the Men's/Women's **Duet** or **Trio** events provided they are not entered in the corresponding Junior Duet or Trio events at the same Championship (ESC General Regulations, Rule 12.12).

### Maximum Entry

The maximum number of starts per event refers to the number of athlete (or team) entries that can be accepted for each European Championship event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a “**waiting list**” will be established for the respective event(s). If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. The ESC/ISSF Headquarters and the Organising Committee will cooperate to determine whether additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

### ID Number

All athletes must have an ISSF ID number. The ISSF ID number can be obtained during the registration process.



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## 5. ENTRY PROCESS

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (**Annex 2.1 – 7.2**) and return them by the established deadlines.

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials for **ISSF-format Events** (refer to the table on Page 1) must be submitted via the **ISSF Entry System** <https://shootingsportscloud.com>.

**For ESC CHALLENGE Events**, (see table on Page 2), **ATHLETE Entries** must be submitted using **ESC Entry System** <https://esc-entry.eu/>

All other Registration Forms must be returned to the **Organising Committee** (see also “Summary of Deadlines”).

### Preliminary Entries

ESC Member Federations entering the Championships must submit the Preliminary Entries no later than **27 JULY 2026**.

### Final Entries

ESC Member Federations must forward their Final Entries directly to the ESC. The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) is **28 AUG 2026**.

### Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries has not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (three (3) days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **23 SEP 2026**.

**Important Note:** Until the Late Entry Deadline (three (3) days before the Official Arrival Day), changes of names/Athletes within an event to the final entries are permitted without restriction or additional fees.

### Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of the participating ESC Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before **12:00 (noon)** on the day before the Technical Meeting

### ENTRY CHANGES AFTER THE LATE ENTRY DEADLINE

From **24 SEP 2026** onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:



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- a) **Replacement of an athlete:** A registered athlete may be replaced by another athlete who is already registered for another event. This replacement must be completed no later than 12:00 (noon) on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that specific event.
- b) **Additional entry due to medical reasons:** An additional entry is permitted only if a registered athlete is unable to participate for medical reasons. This change must be reported no later than 12:00 (noon) on the day before the Technical Meeting.

### **Cancellations**

Any ESC Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes listed in their Final Entries after the Final Entry Deadline (**28 AUG 2026**) must pay the applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs based on the number of athletes and entries included in the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that Federation may participate.

### **Entry Fee**

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transport between the shooting range and the official hotels and anti-doping control.

### **Payment of Entry Fees**

Payments must be made exclusively in Euros (€). These may be settled via bank transfer in advance (amounts must be net of all bank charges) or by cash on arrival at the Accreditation Office for any remaining balances.

- **Cash payments are generally not preferred.**
- Cash will only be accepted in exceptional cases, and for amounts of **maximum €500** (in accordance with Greek law).

**Accreditation Process**

All individuals involved in the Championships (Athletes, Team Officials, ESC/ISSF Officials, Organising Committee Officials, Media personnel) must have an accreditation card. This card must clearly identify the holder with a photograph, family name, first name, nation, and function, in order to use local transport and enter controlled areas at the shooting range.

- **Pre-Registered Persons:** Accreditations for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and with a photograph in the ISSF database will be prepared by the Organising Committee.
- **Late Registrations:** All other accreditations will be prepared by the ECH Accreditation Office.

Accreditations and BIB numbers will be distributed by the Organising Committee after the payment of all entry fees.

**6. SHOOTING RANGE**

The ESC Championship will take place at the Malakasa Shooting Range which is located around 50km north of Athens, in the area of Malakasa-Oropos.

The shooting range has **five (5)** combined ranges for Trap/Skeet. It is equipped with **Promatic** machines and **Progetti** acoustic release systems. All ranges are equipped with electronic scoreboards.

The targets used for the Championships are eco-friendly from **Laporte**. Standard orange targets will be used for the Qualification and flash orange for the Finals.

The Skeet ranges operate with acoustic release systems.



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The firing direction of the shooting range is **East with 27° North**.

## **7. IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS REQUIREMENTS**

### **Entry Visa**

Greece is a member of the European Union and the **Schengen Area**. EU nationals may enter Greece with a valid passport or a valid national identity card.

Participants from countries requiring an **Entry Visa** for Greece should apply to the Greek Embassy or Consulate in their country of residence well in advance of departure.

**Please note** that for some countries, this deadline **may be too late** to allow sufficient time for visa applications.

Please note that the Hellenic Shooting Federation and the Organising Committee have no influence over embassy decisions. Invitations can only be issued for the duration of the European Championship and any official pre-event training.

**Visas Will Not be granted upon arrival at the airport.**

### **Customs Formalities, Import of Weapons**

Upon entering Greece, you must present an invitation letter and declare all firearms to the police at the border. You will be required to present an official firearms owner's certificate.

**EU Firearms Pass Holders:** Participants with a valid EU Firearms Pass simply need to present it to the police officer. No additional forms or taxes are required.

**NON-EU PARTICIPANTS (or those without an EU Firearms Pass):**



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### **Import and Registration of Firearms and Ammunition**

In order to comply with Greek firearms legislation, a firearms permit must be issued by the Greek State for the duration of the ESC Shotgun Championship for every firearm entering the country for training and competition purposes.

To facilitate this process, each athlete must submit:

- a completed copy of the attached firearms declaration form, and
- a copy of their valid shooting licence issued in their home country

These documents must be submitted prior to arrival.

It is the responsibility of the National Federations to complete the required forms with all necessary information regarding the firearms and ammunition to be brought into Greece by their athletes. Upon arrival at the Hellenic Customs Authorities, the declared equipment will be registered and must correspond exactly to the information submitted in advance.

All persons who will have access to the firearms must also be registered. The registration is valid for the duration of the athlete's stay in Greece and expires on the day of departure.

Please note that, without the required permit, firearms will be detained by Greek Customs upon arrival and will not be released until all necessary documentation has been completed and the permits issued.

All athletes and team officials must comply with Greek firearms legislation and Customs regulations concerning the import and re-export of firearms. The permit issued by the Greek State requires that all firearms are re-exported at the end of the competition and may not remain in the country under any circumstances.

National Federations are requested to forward this information to all athletes and any team officials who may handle firearms in Greece.

It is recommended that all delegations carry a complete list of firearms and ammunition (Annex 7.2 – Excel file), to be presented to customs or border police upon request, together with the official invitation.

While bookings are made on a '**first-come, first-served**' basis—meaning priority is given to teams that submit their reservation and **80% deposit** sooner—the **organiser** reserves the right to **optimise** room allocations. This ensures that members of the same team are accommodated together, as many hotels in Chalkida have limited capacity.

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**Penalty Fees for Cancellation**

## **10. COMPETITION RELATED PROCEDURES**

### **Technical Meetings**

The Technical Meetings will take place on **28<sup>th</sup> SEP 2026 (Skeet)** and on the **6<sup>th</sup> October 2026 (Trap)** at the Rifle/Pistol Range. Each participating ESC Member Federation is kindly requested to ensure at least one representative is present to receive updated information regarding the **Final Competition** and **Training Schedules**, draw procedures, and other important matters related to the Championships.

The meeting time will be confirmed following the **Final Entry Deadline**.

### **Storage of Firearms and Ammunition**

The **Armoury** (Weapons Storage) is located at the shooting range and will be open daily from 07:00 until 30 minutes after the end of the final event of the day.

A fully secured, 24-hour guarded storage area within the shooting range is also available if required. Please note that, under local law, no special authorisation is required to transport firearms and ammunition between the place of accommodation and the shooting range.

Federations wishing to use the armoury service will be charged an additional fee of **€20.00 per shotgun**. This fee must be paid to the Organising Committee together with the entry fees.
