## GENERAL INFORMATION

### 1. GENERAL

The 2021 European Championship - EP SO 2021 will take place in Osijek - Croatia, from May 20<sup>th</sup> to June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021, as follows:

Official Arrival: 20 May 2021  
Technical Meeting - Rifle/Pistol: 21 May 2021  
Technical Meeting - Shotgun: 23 May 2021  
Competitions: 22 May till 05 June 2021  
Official Departure: 06 June 2021

All the members of the European Shooting Confederation are invited to participate without any exception.

### Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting:

- for rifle & pistol will take place on 21 May 2021, around 12:30h, at the shooting range,
- for shotgun will take place on 23 May 2021, around 18:00h, at the shooting range,

Each participating ESC Member Federation should have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule), draw procedures and other important issues related to the European Shooting Championship.

25m:	40 firing lines for pistol

Final Hall:	10/15 firing lines for Rifle / Pistol in all events

### **The Shotgun Ranges**

5 combined range for TRAP / SKEET equipped with Mattarelli clay target throwing machines and Progetti phonopul systems.

The firing direction of the shooting range is north/north east.

The targets used for the European Championship will be Eurotarget: Sagittario 2000 orange for the Qualification and Winner flash orange purple powder for the Finals.

## **4. COMPETITION SCHEDULE**

Enclosed you will find a detailed Preliminary Competition Schedule.

The final Competition Schedule including training schedule will be distributed after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the official arrival day). The latest updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

## **5. RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The European Championship will be conducted according to the ESC General Regulations and the ISSF Rules and Regulations – Detailed information is available on the ISSF website [www.issf-sports.org](http://www.issf-sports.org)

Information about the rules of non-ISSF events is available on the ESC website [www.esc-shooting.org](http://www.esc-shooting.org)

In case of disagreement in the interpretation of the rules, the valid English text shall prevail. Jury members (Competition Jury, RTS Jury and Equipment Control Jury) will be nominated by ESC to supervise the European Championship.

The equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF rules using approved instruments.

### **Rifle / Pistol Equipment**

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory, however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

### **Rifle Clothing**

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the

affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled.

Athletes that wish to replace a registered jacket or trouser with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

#### **Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing**

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

#### **Air or CO2 Cylinders**

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

#### **Shotgun Equipment / Control**

All skeet athletes must have an ISSF seal with serial number on the marker tapes of their shooting vests. Any shooting vests that do not have an ISSF seal on the marker tapes must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and for the affixing of a seal before the competition. Equipment Control will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment or/and clothing to the Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

#### **Cartridge Controls**

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested, first. If the pellet weight of both cartridges is 24.50 g or less each, no further action will be taken. If the pellet weight of one (1) or both cartridges is more than 24.50g each, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average pellet weight of the six (6) cartridges is more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ). During Finals, all six (6) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Finals and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Finalists must report at least 15 minutes before the start of the Final. A one-point (1) penalty will be deducted from the score of the team's first hit target if a team's cartridges or if a team member does not report on time. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes, and the boxes will be sealed. The boxes must be left under the supervision of the Equipment Control Jury Member on the FOP. Once ammunition is placed in the box and sealed, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove ammunition from the box. No additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Finals (there will be no elimination for 6th place; the first elimination will be for 5th place).

**Colored Wads**

Only transparent or translucent wads with no color may be used. If an athlete uses ammunition that is not in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 a), then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ)

Results obtained during European Championships will be recognized as MQS for the 2021 OG.

**7. PARTICIPATION AND ENTRY PROCESS**

European Championship ESC Member Federations may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual event as indicated in the ESC "General Regulations" (article 6.5.5)

**Additional Athletes**

Up to two (2) additional athletes per Olympic event may be invited to shoot for MQS, but only if the range capacity allows additional participants (ESC Rule 6.5.7.1). These two (2) additional athletes must not be ranked in the official result list. They must be listed separately according to their results, but without ranking (ESC Rule 6.5.7.1.1). Exchange of an athlete competing in the individual and/or team events with a MQS athlete is not permitted. A MQS athlete may replace a withdrawn team athlete. The withdrawn team athlete may not shoot for MQS.

**Juniors:**

Juniors are athletes who will be under the age of 21 on December 31<sup>st</sup> in the year of the competition. ESC GR 5.5.1

In the European Championship each nation can enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete in the Final for the medals. The other two (2) can only compete for the ranking points ISSF GR 7.5.4.

Upon Arrival the Team leader must declare the (3) three athletes compete for the medals.

The Presidium Members decide: *exceptionally allow Juniors at the 2021 European Championships in Osijek, Croatia, to participate in two categories, i.e. in senior's events of 10m Air Rifle/Air Pistol and in junior's events of 25/50/300m Shotgun or in junior's events of 10m Air Rifle/Air Pistol and in senior's events of 25/50/300m Shotgun.*

At the initially staged 10m Air Rifle/Air Pistol event in Finland, Juniors could have participated in "Junior category" and later on in Osijek in the "Senior category" (and vice versa) in the 25/50/300m event without any restrictions by Article 5.5.2 ESC GR.

To simplify the practical implementation of the ESC Presidium decision, there will be two separate online registrations of the Rifle/Pistol entries for the 2021 European Championship in Osijek: one for 10m events and another for 25/50/300m events.

### **Mixed Team Events**

In the Mixed Team Competitions (composed of 1 man and 1 woman), a maximum of two (2) teams per country are allowed to be entered. No mixed nation teams are allowed.

The Mixed team and Team Competitions rules are published on ISSF web site ([https://www.issf-sports.org/theissf/rules\\_and\\_regulations/general\\_technical\\_rules.ashx](https://www.issf-sports.org/theissf/rules_and_regulations/general_technical_rules.ashx)).

### **Team Events**

The registration of the athletes in the Team Events (each team will be composed of 3 members) will be done automatically from the individual registration.

The federation, which doesn't want to participate in Team Event, must inform the Organizing Committee. The registration will be done automatically following the individual registration.

The Mixed Teams and Teams must be composed of participants of the respective individual events among M and W or MJ and WJ.

## 8. PRELIMINARY ENTRIES

ESC Member Federations participating in the 2021 European Championship must submit their Preliminary Entries not later than **1<sup>st</sup> March 2021**.

There will be two separate online registrations of the Rifle/Pistol entries for the 2021 European Championship in Osijek: one for 10m events and another for 25/50/300m events.

For Preliminary Entries please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <http://entry.issf-sports.info> or exceptionally complete the attached Preliminary Entry Form (Annex 1.1 & 1.2) and return it to the ISSF Headquarters by fax or email and **to the Organizing Committee**.

## 9. FINAL ENTRIES

Final entry registration for athletes and officials must be made by online ISSF registration at <http://entry.issf-sports.info> not later than **April 20, 2021**.

There will be two separate online registrations of the Rifle/Pistol entries for the 2021 European Championship in Osijek: one for 10m events and another for 25/50/300m events.

All other forms (*Final Travel Form, Final Hotel Reservation Form, Final Hotel Rooming List, Visa Support Form, Firearms and Ammunition Form, Media Accreditation Form*) should be sent to the Organizing Committee to e-mail: [competition.osijek@gmail.com](mailto:competition.osijek@gmail.com)

## 10. LATE ENTRIES

Late Entries will be allowed to participate only according to the corresponding ESC and ISSF rules (ESC General Regulations 9.4.2; ISSF rule 8.3.2.).

Any additional entries received after the deadline of three (3) days before the official arrival day i.e. **May 20, 2021** will not be taken into consideration (ESC General Regulations 9.4.4, ISSF Rule 8.3.3).

**11. REPLACEMENTS**

Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete for the Championship is permitted. This change can only be made before 12:00 pm (noon). on the day before the pre-event training for that event (ESC General Regulations 9.4.5, ISSF Rule 8.3.4).

**12. ENTRY CONFIRMATION UPON ARRIVAL**

All Team Leaders are required to report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. This confirmation must take place before 12:00 on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

**13. CANCELATIONS**

Any Federation that reduces the number of athletes and/or officials after the final entry deadline is obliged to pay all applicable fees and costs including entry fees according to the number of entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate (ESC General Regulations 7.3, ISSF Rule 8.4.4).

**14. ISSF ID NUMBER**

According to ESC General Regulations, all athletes must have an official ISSF ID number before participation in any ESC Championship. No athlete without an ISSF ID Number will be allowed to participate.

**15. ENTRY FEES**

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

The Entry Fees DO NOT include the Pre-Event, Official or Unofficial Trainings for shotgun.

## 16. VISA TO ENTER CROATIA

Citizens of most European countries do not need entry visas for Croatia. However, competitors from some countries should obtain an entry visa from the nearest Croatian consular department.

Each participating federation requiring visa should fill out the "Visa Support Form" (Annex 3) and return it to the Organizing Committee within the required deadline.

## 17. ACCOMMODATION AND HOTEL RESERVATION

Osijek is the city with many small hotels and our plan is to use 2 or 3 hotels with 4\* about 20 to 35 km outside from Osijek.

We assembled hotels into three **OUR** categories.

*Although the booking will be based on the principle "first come, first served" (teams making the reservation and transferring 80% of the deposit sooner, will have the privilege to choose), due to the fact that Osijek has a large number of small hotels, the organizer retains the right to perform the optimal booking to avoid accommodating the members of the same team in different hotels.*

## 18. TRANSPORT

The Organizing Committee will provide the transport service for all the delegations between the official airports and the official hotels during the official days of the 2021 European Championship – EPSO 2021 (May 20 / June 6, 2021).

The official airports are:

1. Airport „KLISA“ – Osijek  
- located 20 km from shooting range „PAMPAS“ - [www.osijek-airport.hr](http://www.osijek-airport.hr)
2. Airport „FRANJO TUĐMAN“ – Zagreb  
- the main Croatian airport located in Zagreb, 300 km from Osijek, and well connected to many European destinations - [www.zagreb-airport.hr](http://www.zagreb-airport.hr)

The transportation from and to the Airport „KLISA“ - Osijek is free of charge.

According to the ESC Presidium decision, the transportation from and to the Airport „FRANJO TUĐMAN“ – Zagreb will be charged 80 € per person (both ways).

The Organizing Committee will also provide local transportation on the daily basis between the official hotels and the shooting range, according to the official transport schedule.

The transport service will be effective from May 20 till June 6, 2021.

Delegations staying in the unofficial hotels will be responsible for their own transportation.

## 19. ACCREDITATION & PAYMENT

The reception and accreditation for all participants and guests will be organized at the Shooting range PAMPAS, where the payment of the entry fees and payment of the hotel accommodation (the

remaining 20%) will be made. All the expenses have to be paid to the Organizing Committee in EUROS by bank transfer or **in cash**. Please note that no credit cards or traveler checks will be accepted on site!

## 20. FIREARMS CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

When entering Croatia, you will need to have an invitation letter and claim possession of the firearms (present an official firearms owners' certificate) to the police officer when crossing the border.

- Persons with an EU firearm permits just have to show EU firearms permit to police officer and do not need to show any other forms or pay any taxes.
- Persons arriving from outside the EU or don't have an EU firearm permits, will get an official form from the police when crossing the border, on which they can register up-to three weapons.

Police will issue papers for these firearms, which you must show at departure during check-in and to the police officer.

The tax of 70 Croatian Kuna (around 9 EUR) is requested for every submitted form.

**Upon arrival** to Croatia all firearms and ammunition must be transported directly to the Shooting range firearms storage.

**At departure** the firearms and ammunition have to be collected from the firearms storage on the way to airport (not before).

## 21. STORAGE OF FIREARMS

Storage of firearms and equipment will be available at the Shooting range "PAMPAS" without charge. All rifles and pistols must be stored from arrival to departure except during reparation, equipment control, training, and competition.

Firearms and equipment manufacturers with their service facilities will be present during the official days of the European Shooting Championships.

## 22. COMPETITION RELATED PROCEDURES AT THE SHOOTING RANGE

### Ammunition

The use of steel pellets is not allowed.

Local company will offer ammunition for:

- trap: RC2, RC4, Fiocchi, Clever, B&P and Croatian M-90.
- Skeet: B&P and Fiocchi.

Price per box of 25 cartridges: from 6 to 11 EUR.

For all interested in this please send request in advance, but not later than 01.04.2021.

## 23. DOPING CONTROL

Doping tests as required by the ISSF Rules and Regulations will be performed in all events and all categories at the shooting range.

## 24. FIRST AID

The first aid station will be placed at Shooting Range Pampas next to the Doping Control.

## **25. CEREMONIES**

ALL awarding ceremonies will take place at the shooting range PAMPAS, daily after the finals or qualifications at the awarding area.

## **26. NATIONAL ANTHEM AND FLAG**

OC will prepare all national anthem. During accreditation team leader of each delegation must check its own national anthem and confirm.

National flags will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

## **27. EXHIBITIONS**

The exhibition area for firearm and equipment manufacturers will be provided at shooting range.

## **28. MEDIA CENTER**

The MEDIA center will be available at the shooting range and equipped according to the ISSF General regulation chapter 11.

All media representatives of the relevant ESC countries will be invited through the ESC member federations.

Before attending the Championship, all media representatives must register by sending the "Media Accreditation Form" (Annex 5) to the Organizing Committee within the deadline.

## **29. FOOD SERVICE**

On the venue there will be a restaurant with a buffet table with food and drinks.

For all national teams the OC will prepare a special offer with reasonable price and option to order meals in advance and pay by bank transfer.

We hope you find this convenient for you.

Specific dietary requirements should be advised by the final deadline, every effort will be made to cater accordingly if sufficient notice is given.

## **30. COVID-19 INFORMATION**

OC will inform all member federations 1 month before official arrival about COVID-19 current situation.
