Dear Colleagues,

It is to inform that the XXVIII General Assembly of the European Shooting Confederation will take place in Baku, Azerbaijan, on October 22nd-24th, 2021. This decision was taken by the ESC Presidium on March 11th, 2021.

In this connection I would like to remind that, according to Article 5.3 of the ESC Statutes, in order to be included in the agenda to be considered at the General Assembly, the President (even per facsimile or e-mail) must receive the matters in one of the official languages at least three (3) months before the General Assembly convenes. It means, that all proposals on matters to be included in the agenda of the General Assembly must be submitted by the Member Federations no later than July 21st, 2021.

By the same date the ESC Secretariat must receive nominations for the elective positions and applications for the European Championships.

There will be elections for the positions of President, Vice-Presidents, Presidium members, Chairman of the Technical Committee and Auditors.

The applications will be accepted for the 2024 European Championship 10m, the 2024 European Championship Shotgun, the 2024 European Championship Juniors 25m/50m/RT, the 2025 European Championship 10m, and the 2025 European Championship 25m/50m/300m/RT/Shotgun.
